VISITING ACADEMIC POSITION

The Department of English Studies at the University of Cyprus invites applications for a Visiting Academic position at the rank of Lecturer or Assistant Professor for the Fall Semester 2019-2020 (02/09/2019 – 31/12/2020).

TEACHING REQUIREMENTS

The successful candidates will be required to teach:

ENG 25x: Topics in Phonetics and Phonology, a second-year undergraduate course, compulsory for the Linguistics track of the BA in English Studies; and/or

ENG 340: Language Change and Development, a third-year undergraduate course, compulsory for the Linguistics track of the BA in English Studies; and/or

ENG 350: EFL Teaching Methodology, a third-year compulsory undergraduate course; and/or
Up to three elective courses within her/his specialization, which would be advanced seminars to third- and fourth-year undergraduate students for the Linguistics track.

Monthly gross salaries for these positions as Visitors are approximately:

Visiting Academic (Assistant Professor): €3,115,01

Visiting Academic (Lecturer): €2,716,98

The above amounts can be subject to changes imposed by the Government.

QUALIFICATIONS

The successful candidate will be required to teach and guide students. She or he will also administer and mark the final exam for the course she or he will teach.

Applicants need not be citizens of the Republic of Cyprus. Applicants should however ensure, before applying, that in case they are selected they will be residing in Cyprus on a full-time basis during the employment period; submission of application implies acceptance of this condition. Acceptance of this term must be also explicitly stated in the letter of application.

APPLICATION

Applicants should hold a PhD on a relevant subject.

Applicants should submit the following:

- I. Letter of application
- II. Curriculum Vitae

- III. Copies of degrees and transcripts. The successful candidate(s) will be asked to submit certified copies from the Ministry of Education of Cyprus (if degrees were acquired in Cyprus) or from the respective institution abroad
- IV. Two representative publications

If applying for the first time to the Department, applicants must also arrange for two academic referees to send letters of recommendation directly to it (see below). The names and addresses of these referees must be submitted with the application.

Selected candidates will be required to submit copies of degree certificates officially certified by the Ministry of Education (for certificates received from Universities in Cyprus) or from the Issuing Authority (for foreign Universities).
