

Prof. Kleopas A. Kleopa, MD, graduated from Medical School University of Wuerzburg, Germany and was trained in Neurology and Neuromuscular Disorders at Drexel University and University of Pennsylvania, USA. He is a consultant neurologist, Head of Neurology Clinic E and Neuroscience Laboratory at the Cyprus Institute of Neurology and Genetics (CING) and Professor at the Cyprus School of Molecular Medicine, coordinating the Neuroscience MSc/PhD Program and teaching as course leader the Molecular and Cellular Neuroscience course. He chairs the Academic Committee and coordinates medical student and neurology resident education at CING. He has expertise in the clinical diagnosis and management of neurological and in particular neuromuscular disorders. Furthermore, he has extensive experience in both basic and clinical neuroscience research, with competitive research funding totaling over €3 million for the last 18 years. He has obtained as a principal investigator over 20 research grants and has published over 80 peer reviewed papers in international scientific journals. He received the 2015 Investigator Award from the European Academy of Neurology and the 2017 Distinguished Researcher Award of the Cyprus Research Promotion Foundation.
