The Department of Economics at the University of Cyprus invites applications for one (1) Special Scientist position (Teaching) to cover the teaching needs of the Department during the Spring Semester 2021/22. The filling of the position is subject to the availability of funding.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teaching a postgraduate course, 3 hours per week.
- Support students at least 2 hours per week as office hours to solve questions and complete assignments.
- Administer and mark midterm and final exam.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Doctoral Degree (PhD) from a recognized university in Finance or in Economics with specialization in Finance.
- Very good knowledge of English and Greek.

EMPLOYMENT TERMS:

Special Scientist remuneration is €66 per teaching hour and paid employment for the Spring Semester 2021-22 is for 15 weeks. Payment is made as follows: remuneration X teaching hours per week X duration of the Spring Semester 2021–2022. Employee contributions to the various State Funds will be deducted from the above amounts.

In case an applicant is employed in the public or wider public sector of the Republic of Cyprus, they must obtain in advance permission to work at the University from the appropriate Department/Ministry, or wider public sector authority.

Applicants should submit the following:

- I. Application cover letter stating their interest in teaching and their relevant teaching experience.
- II. Curriculum Vitae
- III. Copies of diplomas

The candidate selected will be asked to submit certified copies of diplomas from the Ministry of Education of Cyprus in case the degrees were acquired in Cyprus, or from the respective institution abroad.
