

Zoe Giannousi works as a psychologist at the Bank of Cyprus Oncology Centre, Cyprus since 2011. After finishing her BA in Psychology at the University of Crete (1998) and obtaining her MSc in Health Psychology (2000) from the University of Surrey, she completed her PhD at the Department of Medicine, University of Crete (2010) entitled "Illness Perceptions and Levels of Depression in Cancer Patients". From 2006 to 2014 she completed her training in Systemic Psychotherapy (1000 hours) and became a member of the European Family Therapy Association. From 2005 until 2011 she worked at the Department of Medical Oncology at the University Hospital of Heraklion, Greece where she also took part in research in parallel to her clinical work.
