<p>COSME Programme, "Supporting the Promotion and Development of Transnational Thematic Tourism Products Linked to Cultural and Creative Industries" - COS-TOURCCI-2017-3-03</p> <p>This specific call for proposals aims at supporting the development and, in particular, the promotion of transnational thematic tourism products through cultural and creative industries (CCIs), sub-sector Cultural Heritage, with involvement of SMEs and in close cooperation with the Member States. A particular focus will be put on using CCIs-related technologies in promoting these tourism products and enhancing visitor's experience.</p> <p>Eligible applicants: Applicants must be fully or partly public or private bodies; private bodies must be properly constituted and registered under national law. Applicants must correspond to the definition of at least one of the following target organisations active in the field of tourism, cultural and creative industry (CCIs): public authorities and their networks or associations, managing authorities of UNESCO cultural sites; training or educational institutions including universities, research centres, chambers of commerce and industry, destination management organisations and their networks/associations, travel agents and tour operators and their umbrella associations; not-for profit/non-governmental organisations, civil society organisations, foundations, think-tanks, SMEs acting in the tourism or CCIs, national, regional, local tourism organisations, public and private agencies related to tourism, cultural heritage promotion or regional development, etc.</p>	<p>29/06/2017</p>
